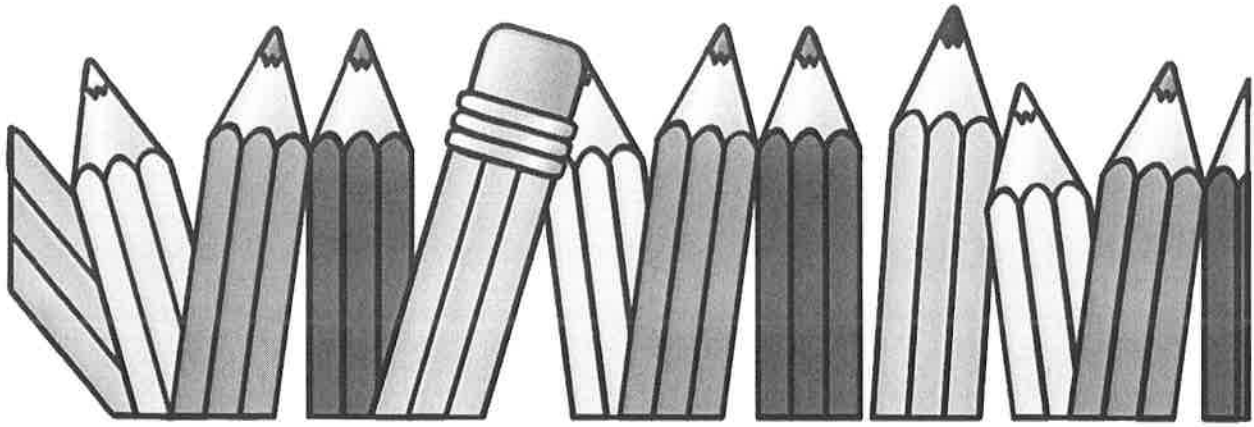

Snacks to be passed out to class - I like to provide a midday snack, any help is really appreciated!!!!





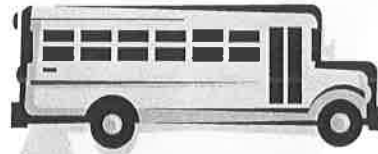
Welcome to Ms. Northington's Classroom

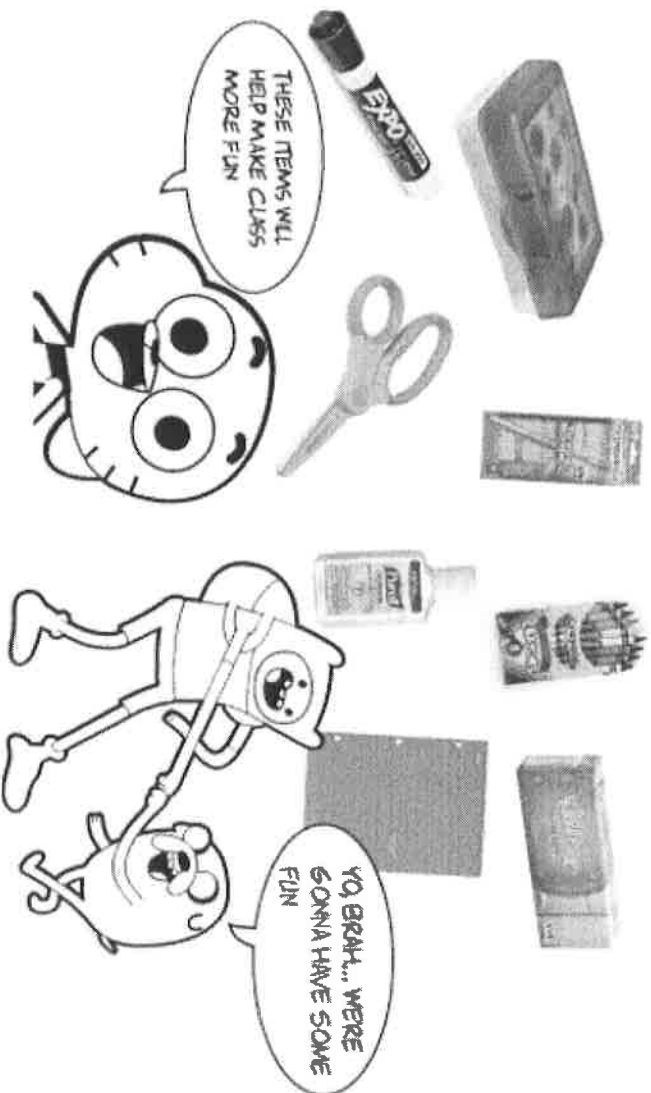
